We are so happy to have everyone back at school and the school is once again full of hustle and bustle. The children have been so good at returning to school and they all seem to have settled back into school really well. They have told us that they are so happy to be with their friends and to be able to play and run around. Obviously we have focussed on school routines and procedures this week and they are following them well even though this is the first week back since the Christmas holidays.

We have staggered start times for each year and designated waiting areas for so that the playground does not get too congested and a safe distance of 2 metres can be maintained. However, we notice that when the gates open at 8:30am some parents are arriving too early and not waiting in their allotted areas until their child's classroom door opens. Please can we ask that you don't arrive until 5 minutes before your child's door opens. Obviously if you are a Key Stage One parent with a child in the Early Years you will need to wait the ten minutes between your child being dropped off at Nursery or Reception. Can we also remind you that there is a one-way system on site and please can you adhere to it. All these measures are for you and your children's safety, we are still under lockdown.
