## Dear Parents & Carers Happiness and wonder inspires success

Another week has flown past and soon we shall be in May. Let's hope the weather improves in May or at least warms up a little. On Monday the children were outside enjoying the sunshine, by today they were wearing their coats, hats and gloves to keep warm. Typical English weather!

Our overall Umbrella school focus this half term is 'Green Fingers' which every year group, at their appropriate level have been doing through a carefully selected book. Nursery are using 'Jasper's Beanstalk', Reception are using 'The Enormous Turnip', Year 1 are using 'Jim and the Beanstalk' and Year 2 are using 'The Flower'.

All the classes have been working extremely hard and producing some brilliant work. Year 2 have been concentrating on innovating their focus story, changing different parts of the story to make it their own. Year 1 have looked at character descriptions of the giant, focussing on adjectives. They have also explored the story of 'Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat' and I have to say I was extremely impressed with some of their writing and coat designs.



In Reception, the focus has been on developing the children's reading and subtraction skills in maths. This time of year is vitally important for the Reception children to gain the skills ready for Key Stage 1.

In Nursery we have planted an array of seeds... it will be a surprise when they grow because some of the seeds got mixed up! They have also been painting flowers and making flowers from collage, as well as trying to agree what might be at the top of Jasper's beanstalk, would it be a giant's castle like the traditional story?
