They have done some independent writing and have been practising their addition and subtraction skills. In Year 1, we have begun the Phonic Screening, to identify any gaps in the children's knowledge of letter sounds, digraphs and tri-graphs, which supports their reading and writing. We can then put in extra support for those children that progress has been delayed due to missing so much school this academic year.

On Wednesday evening, we held a virtual full governing body meeting and brought the governors up to date with what had been happening in school and the progress the children have made in their learning, despite the lockdown due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Next week is our final week before half term, hasn't the time flown by since we came back since Easter. Next half term we will be making arrangements for the next academic year and the children will be having taster sessions with their new teachers in their new classrooms. We also intend to have face to face Parent consultations where we will share the progress your child is making, despite Covid, and also provide you with a written report of their achievements and things they can do at home to support their learning. The consultations will take place during school time in the afternoons.
