We would like to thank those parents in Year 1 who were asked to support their child in practising the Phonic sounds during the half term break; we can see the difference it has made to those children that did.

The children all seem happy to be back and eager to start their new topics. The over-arching theme this half term is how we can look after the earth and make changes that improve the world's environment. Whilst we are all looking at the same theme, each year builds on previous learning.

In Year 2 their book is 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley', focussing on our oceans and different layers to them and how our actions impact on the oceans environment and sea creatures. They have created a display using items from home. The sand is from the Devon coast.



Year 1 are looking how the Rainforest destruction is causing harm to the animals that live there as well as the impact on our world. Their book is 'There's a Rang Tan in my bedroom', a story about a baby orang-utan who comes to live with a little girl because the humans have burnt his home down.

Reception are focussing on the story of 'Litterbug Doug meets Michael Recycle'. Children are focussing on reducing the amount of rubbish that is thrown away and how we can re-use things. They no longer have a home corner, but a recycling centre.

Nursery have been listening to 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and thinking about the life cycle of a butterfly. They have actually got some tiny caterpillars that they will watch grow bigger and change.
