Happiness and wonder inspires success

The last full week of our Summer term is now upon us. It is with regret that Parents are unable to attend Sports events due to the guidelines, however we shall be taking lots of video clips and photographs which we shall share with you on the school's website and learning platform. We are praying for nice weather so that we can go ahead as the children always enjoy it. The Year 2 children are to wear their sports kits to school on Monday, Year 1 on Tuesday and Early Years (Reception and Nursery) on Wednesday.

Last week, we held interviews for two teaching assistant roles; one in Early Years and one in Key Stage 1. We are pleased to tell you that we have appointed Mrs Rosson to work with the Year 1 team and Miss Colston to work with our Early Years team, sharing her time between Nursery and Reception.

Mrs Hodnette, our Speech and Language Therapist, who is currently on Maternity leave visited last week with her baby daughter, Cleo. It was lovely to see her and even lovelier to meet her daughter for the first time. She is carrying out several 'keeping in touch days' during her maternity leave and liaising with staff to ensure that the children have made the progress expected in speech and language and to advise on the next steps for those still receiving support.

Mrs Simm and Mr Attwood from the Junior school, together with another Head, held interviews this week to appoint a Family Support Worker to work within the 'Senneleys Consortium of Schools', of which we are part of. The funding for this appointment comes from Birmingham City Council's SEND budget to try to ensure that children are 'school ready'. The candidate selected, Rebecca Brittle, has a background in Early Years education, Social work and Family Support Work, and we are looking forward to working with her.

Children in Reception and Year 1 have found out today who their new teachers are going to be in September and due to Covid restrictions, they met them in the playground instead of going into the enclosed classrooms. Our Reception staff will be remaining the same and we will be appointing a new Nursery teacher before the end of term.
