Dear Parents & Carers

Happiness and wonder inspires success

Welcome back to school! We hope you had a good Easter holiday and the children have recharged their batteries for the final term of this academic year.

On Monday the staff all attended training for Team Teach which we undertake every three years. This supports us in de-escalation strategies and in extreme cases how we can move children to a safe place with minimum contact. Our children are very well behaved and we rarely, if ever have to use the strategies.

On Thursday our new Sports Coach, started and he worked with Year 1 and Year 2 and in addition ran a Lunchtime activity and an Afterschool club. His name is Mr Welch and he will be with us every Thursday. The children thoroughly enjoyed the sessions. Mr Welch said how impressed he was with our children's good behaviour and how well they listened and responded to instructions.

Year 1 went on their first educational trip today, they have visited Blists Hill, a Victorian Town near Ironbridge. They should have gone at the end of last term but due to the number of children absent due to COVID or chickenpox, it was postponed to the beginning of this term. They are experiencing what it was like to be a child in a Victorian school - hopefully they'll be glad to get back to Bellfield!

Next week the children will only be in school for three days as it is a Bank Holiday on Monday and the school is closed on Thursday. The Infant school is used as a Polling station for the local elections which is on Thursday. The staff will be in school working on planning and preparation and gathering information for the information needed to write school reports.

We have had the names of the children who will be joining us in September in our reception classes. We have a number coming to us from our Day Care and our school Nursery and the rest from other Nurseries and day care provisions. We shall be holding welcome sessions for these families in June so they can come and meet the staff and become familiar with their new surroundings in preparation for their start in September.

We still have places available in our Nursery for both part-time and full-time places. We also offer full time places for those who are not funded at a reasonable cost too. Please contact the School Office for more information.

Please can I remind parents to supervise their children at all times before school starts and at the end of the day when they have been collected. Children should not be riding bikes or scooters or playing football either at these times.
