Mrs Simm, Mr Rudge and Mr Attwood interviewed candidates for Mr Cox's position on Wednesday afternoon and they were able to appoint Mr Pepall as our new assistant site manager and he will be joining us the week after half term.

Mrs Simm attended a Northfield Early Years Network Meeting on Thursday morning and she said how good it was to finally meet up with colleagues in person again rather than virtually after nearly two years. The Network is focussing on Developing Early Provision (DLP) for the Early Years children in the area, this is similar to the DLP for primary schools which provides us with our Family Support Worker, Becky Brittle whom some of you have met. We also discussed the Start Well programme that Day Care is involved in and how helpful it is. If you receive Universal Credit you could be entitled to vouchers each week and they also provide free vitamins for all in Birmingham. It really would be worth checking out whether you are eligible by looking at their website.

We are also asking that the children create a crown at home and they can wear these to school on Friday. We will hold a competition to see whose crown is the best. All children will be receiving a book together with a small gift from school to commemorate the Queen's 70 years, Platinum Jubilee.

The National Healthy Start scheme provides free vouchers each week to spend on cow's milk, fresh, frozen and tinned fruit and vegetables, fresh, dried, and tinned pulses and infant formula. You can get free vouchers or payments every 4 weeks. If you are pregnant or have children under the age of 4 you could qualify if you are on benefits or under 18 and pregnant. 
