This week Year 2 have completed their assessments and their teachers are pleased with their results especially when you consider how disruptive the two previous years have been.

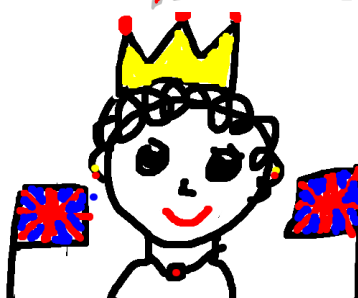
