Dear Parents & Carers

Happiness and wonder inspires success

The weather has been good this week and the children have enjoyed being able to make the most of going outside. They have had their PE lessons outside too where possible. Nursery children visited the 'big' playground for the first time and were very adventurous climbing on the play equipment and shooting down the slides.

The children have completed all their assessments and because they have worked so hard throughout this year, we could not be prouder of the progress they have made. Year One achieved an 80% pass rate in their phonic assessment. In addition to this, our school was trialling the new NFER assessment test for phonics and Gill Richards, who came to make sure it was carried out properly, was so impressed with our children's phonological knowledge and how they apply this to read words, some of them very tricky words too!

On Thursday, Lisa Fraser, Assistant Director of Education and Early Years came to visit our school. Lisa came to discuss Early Years education, the support that schools need, how we can become more inclusive in light of the difficulty with placing children in Special school. She had a tour of our visited every class and Day Care. She said how friendly the children were and what a bright environment the school was. We discussed that our school budget is extremely tight but we make sure our children have the best we can offer them. We said that we are an inclusive school and we go above and beyond to accommodate children by ensuring quiet areas for those who cannot cope with a loud classroom; we provide specialist Speech and Language support as well as spending a significant amount on outside agencies so our children can get the support they need.

Next week we shall be holding inductions for our children starting Nursery and Reception in September. The children and parents will meet all the staff, hear what kind of activities the children will be doing when they start school and have a chance to see their classroom and have a chat with their new teachers.

Transition arrangements

There will be three further settling in mornings for the children between 9:30 - 11:00am on Friday 1st July Friday 8th July Friday 15th July

At these Friday morning transition sessions, children can really become familiar with the school in readiness for September. Our current Reception children will go to their new classes in Year 1 and Year 1 children will go to their new classes in Year 2. The current Year 2 will visit the Junior School and become familiar with the new school. Most children look forward to a new start but some children do not cope well with change so it is important that we keep talking to them and allay any anxieties that they might have.
