Dear Parents & Carers

We have finally arrived at half term; we hope you have a restful holiday and everyone manages to recharge their batteries. We return to school on Monday 27th February and fingers crossed, we can return in warmer Spring weather.

The children who read to an adult at home a minimum of 3 times a week, and have detailed written comments in their Monkey Diaries, will receive a Bookworm Certificate to acknowledge they are working hard to improve their reading at every opportunity. Children who are absent will not be penalised as long as they have been listened to and have three written comments. Fortunately, it has been brought to our attention that some children had missed out because they were away on a Monday when reading books were changed and consequently didn't receive their award. We hope that this clarifies when children qualify to receive their Bookworm certificate. We appreciate that many parents are busy juggling jobs and looking after their family but please listen to your child read as it is one of the main positive impacts in their learning progression.

The musical performance practices are going well and this week the children in Year 2 have been making bird puppets to use in their performance.





Parent Consultation appointments are available on SchoolPing so make sure you book a time to talk to your child's teacher to find out how they are progressing and to have a look at the work in their books.

We are now actively seeking a new Head teacher and already there have been quite a few candidates enquiring about the role and making appointments to come and look around the school. We are also still looking for a Special Educational Needs Leader but, in the meantime, Mrs Farrell has agreed to stay with us until we appoint her replacement which we are extremely grateful to her for.

Can I remind everyone that when the classroom doors open in the morning the children are expected to enter their class straightaway. Some children are playing on the apparatus after the bell instead of going into school.

Our school uniform clearly states that black school shoes should be warn. We notice that trainers are being worn by a few children when they should be wearing shoes. We appreciate that sometimes shoes get broken or suddenly are too small and this means that the pupil has to wear alternative footwear for a couple of days but shoes are the correct uniform. If your child comes to school in trainers they will be asked to put pumps on whilst they are in school.
